MEDIASET REACTION TO TODAY'S SENTENCE OF THE EUROPEAN COURT OF JUSTICE

Mediaset has recorded the details of the sentence issued today by the European Court of Justice.

The sentence contains issues that will need to be examined in subsequent phases before a competent national judge to whom we are confident the Italian Communications Authority will provide all the necessary clarifications.

In addition, the Authority will have to assess the risks to pluralism, a value of fundamental importance also under EU law, deriving from the limitless possibilities for dominant players in the telecommunications sector to strengthen their position in the media sector.

If, contrary to the provisions of current Italian legislation, there were to be the possibility for convergence between leading players in both the TLC and television broadcasting sectors, Mediaset, which has long been constrained and penalised by restrictions, would be in a position to evaluate with great interest any new TLC business opportunities, starting from the recent developments regarding a single national fibre system for the internet.
